# INFINITE APPEAL

Leave it to **The Langham** to take its hotel suites to a whole new level of luxe. Situated on the 12th floor overlooking the Chicago River, the just-unveiled 2,700-square-foot **Infinity Suite** has a refreshingly original midcentury modern-meets-art-deco vibe that we go gaga over. The unit features 2.5 baths, two bedrooms, a living room, a dining room, a pantry and an entrance foyer. Designed by London's Richmond International, the firm was influenced by Mies van der Rohe's Tugendhat House in the Czech Republic. Decor elements were hand-plucked for their icon status it seems; here, we call out some of the most envy-inducing pieces.
